## The History of the Witnessing Church Rev. 11:1-6

### Rev. 11:1 John is called to judge the visible church

1. God's temple and those who worship at the altar =
  1. God's temple: 1 Cor. 3:16; 2 Cor. 6:16; Eph. 2:21
  2. Those who worship at the altar: Rom. 12:1; Heb. 12:28-29
2. What is the purpose of measurement?

### Rev. 11:2 John is to distinguish between the true worshippers and the unclean worshippers.

1. The temple = =
2. The outside court = =
3. The holy city = = (Gal. 4:25-27; Heb. 12:22-23)
4. The visible church is mixed with unbelievers. Matt. 13:24-30; 36-40; 47-51
5. How long is this to occur? 42 months, 1260 days, 3.5 times = The NT period from the apostles until the end.
  1. Dan. 7:25
  2. Rev. 11:3
  3. Rev. 12:6
  4. Rev. 13:5
6. The point: The time that unbelievers will occupy a large part of the church and tread believers under foot is limited and under God's control.

### Rev. 11:3-4 The witness of the church will be empowered by the Holy Spirit.

2. The two olive trees = (Zech. 4:2-6)
3. The two lampstands = (Rev. 1:10; Rev. 2-3)
4. Why the number 2?
5. Clothed in sackcloth =
6. The gospel must be preached to the whole world. Matt. 24:14

### Rev. 11:5-7 During the time of the church's witness, it will be empowered and protected.

1. The church is empowered by the Word and the Spirit, the power of the gospel just as God's prophets of old.
  1. The fire =
2. The church is protected by that gospel just as God's prophets of old were protected.
  1. Devours =
  2. Must be killed = (1 Cor. 1:18; 2 Cor. 2:15-16)
