**Rev. 14:14 Jesus ushers in the end.**

1. Jesus returns from heaven (clouds). Matt. 24:30; Matt. 26: 64; Mark 13:26; Mark 14:62
2. Jesus is the "Son of Man." Rev. 1:13; Dan. 7:13; Matt. 13:41
3. Jesus is the king of the earth (crown). Matt. 13:41
