

Revelation Chapter 16

Intro

1. The seventh sign introduces the seven bowls of God's wrath.
2. The questions on the minds of the saints are these:
 3. The seven bowls of God's wrath are poured into the earth by God's authority (16:1).
 4. There is no limitation to the extent of His wrath.
 5. There are four observations.
 1. The contrast with the 7 trumpet warnings of God's wrath is obvious.
 2. The correlation with the plagues in Egypt is obvious.
 3. Observe the response of those marked by the beast.
 4. Observe the response of the saints.

God marks His enemies with sores. Rev. 16:2

God strikes the sea. Rev. 16:3

God strikes the springs of waters. Rev. 16:4

God strikes the sun. Rev. 16:8-9

2. Extent: Contrast with trumpets (8:12).

God strikes the hearts of men. Rev. 16:10-11

2. Extent: Contrast with trumpets (9:1-2; 4-6).

3. Man's response:

God strikes the Euphrates. Rev. 16:12-14, 16

2. Extent: Contrast with trumpets (9:13-15).

3. Har-magedon: The great day of God's wrath against the kings of the earth.

1. The mount of Megiddo: The place where kings are killed or defeated.
