

## **The Marriage Supper of the Lamb Revelation 19:1-10**

### **Introduction**

1. The events of chapters 17-18 are primarily focused on Jesus' work at the cross and the defeat of His enemies, the harlot, the kings of the earth, and the people.
2. However, the battle has been and continues to be waged between the dragon and his allies and the Lamb and those who hold to His testimony.
3. Chapter 19 changes the focus from the world to Jesus and His bride.
4. Another contrast: the world in its harlotry and the bride with her husband.

### **The saints praise God with one voice. 19:1-6**

1. Their praise is similar to that in 7:10.
2. The cause of their praise is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the harlot.

6. The Holy Spirit indicated that the work of the \_\_\_\_\_ and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit were the fulfillment of Joel's prophecy. Acts 2:17-21
7. The Holy Spirit through Paul also mentions the fulfillment of Joel's prophecy in his time. Rom. 10:13.
8. The saints and all creation worship God. Rev. 4:4, 6
9. Jesus calls everyone to praise God and they do. God reigns! 19:5-6

### **Rejoice in that the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride is ready.**

1. When did the marriage of the Lamb and His bride come?
  1. John the Baptist. John 3:29
  2. The Apostle Paul.  
2 Cor. 11:2  
2 Tim. 2:13  
Eph. 5:25-27
2. The traditional Jewish betrothal process is in view.
  1. The betrothal or ketubah
  
  2. The marriage covenant sealed with a cup of wine.

3. A second cup is to be shared when the groom comes for His bride. Luke 22:20; Matt. 26:29
  
4. The bride is made ready.
  1. Rev. 19:7; 21:2, 9, 17
  
  2. She is dressed in her acts. Rev. 19:8; Eph. 2:10; 5:27; Col. 1:22; Titus 2:14; 3:8
3. John was told to write a blessing for his readers. 19:9
  1. Paul's understanding is incredible! 1 Cor. 6:19
  2. John's response to the revelation is worship and awe.
    1. There's a danger when God reveals truth.
    2. The marriage of the Lamb and His bride is God's work. It is the testimony of Jesus.
    3. The messenger merely has the true word of God within him. The glory goes to God, not the messenger. Rev. 19:10; 2 Cor. 6-7
    4. All prophecy has one ultimate end: the testimony of Jesus Christ.

### **Application**

1. Do you consider yourself married to Jesus or do you live like a single person still looking for a husband to fulfill your desires?
2. Together, we are the fulfillment of the rebuilding of the temple and the marriage supper of the Lamb. Rejoice!
